Pete Klismet is an Associate Professor of Criminal Justice at Pikes Peak Community College in Colorado Springs, Colorado, where he has taught classes in Advanced Criminal Investigation and Criminal Personality Profiling for 12 years.

He served as a Patrol Officer, Detective, Sergeant in Patrol, vice and narcotics, and administration with the Ventura Police Department in Southern California for over nine years.

Appointed as a Special Agent with the Federal Bureau of Investigation in 1979, Pete served for over 20 years, with assignments in Los Angeles, Omaha, and Grand Junction, CO.

In 1985, Pete was selected to be one of the original profilers in the newly-developing Behavioral Sciences Unit. He received extensive training for years and, coupled with working closely with law enforcement agencies in the Midwest, had a wealth of experience working cases involving violence and violent sex crimes.

As profiling coordinator for the Omaha Division of the FBI, Pete's additional responsibilities included conducting numerous schools for law enforcement to acquaint them with the newly-developed concept.

Pete received numerous awards and other recognition during his time with the FBI, significant among which was being named the 1999 law officer of the year by a large international organization.

His education includes a Bachelor's Degree in Criminology from Metropolitan State College in Denver, a Master's Degree in Criminal Justice from California Lutheran College in Thousand Oaks, California, and a second Master's Degree in Public Administration from the University of Southern California in Los Angeles.
